We organized VHSND meeting for 1st quarter on two dates 19/06/2020 and 23/06/2020 at ICDS center-113 Musharitola, Madhubanighat and ICDS centre-178, Mathiya madhubanighat respectively. In these two meetings total 78 members including female participated. During the staff meeting we planned out



our role and responsibilities, meeting started with registration process of all participants. Our resource persons gave lectures on GMC of children, importance of immunization and its schedule, some topics covered on adolescent girl and children. addition to it they covered prominent topics like ANC/PNC check-up, Govt. health program, care of SAM child and its referral, exclusively 6-month breast feeding etc. during this quarter ANC-21 Women , TT of PW 17 women, total child vaccination =53 ,GMC of children 32, and found Red-3, yellow 4, Green-25.

Celebration of VHSND/AAROGYA divas was organized in the 2nd quarter at different places mentioned in the above table. It was organized on three dates under the guidance of three resource persons. They educate villagers by their knowledge sharing. The information provided by the resource persons greatly encouraged the villegers. During this quarter 4 SAM children sent to NRC, total ANC183, total PNC 340, total immunization 240, vaccination 194, total TT 69, total institutional delivery 60, GMC 40 was done.

❖ **Health awareness on prevention from Corona virus:-**

we organised health awareness on corona virus on 29-30 June 2020. First day Mr. Rambabu Sahni has inaugurated the program and shown green flag for corona virus jagrukta rath for project area. We covered Garghat, Musahari tola Saraiya, Nayka tola, Pipariya tola, Sahani tola, Paswan tola, Muslim tola and Ahir tola . On Second day (30.06.2020) we covered- Bandhpatti, kalwar tola, Musahari tola Madhubanighat, Nuniya tola , Bin tola , mathiya, Kanhi tola Math tola haraj, harijan tola and musahari tola haraj. We aware people about following things:- Stay away from the crowd, Wear mask, If you have sneezing, head ache, fever and sore throat for more than 6 days, see a doctor as these are symptoms of corona and call to toll free help no. 104, Social distancing, CHARDS animators gave the mobile VANI number to the people and suggested to regularly listen to the information related to the corona virus and tell it to others.

❖ **Awareness on prevention from COVID 19 and help to migrant labour:-**

During the pandemic of COVID 19 CHARDS team aware to the community Like, Right way to hand washing practices How to prevent, corona virus?, Regular Visit of quarantine centre and counselling them, How to benefited from Bihar corona sahayata, Use of listening of Mobile Vani , How to benefited from PDS ,Prepared the list for distribution of Mask and soap with support of PRI members, Encourage to migrant labour for health check-up. Rally with ASHA, ANM ,ICDS worker or prevention from COVID 19, Home visit and counselling on COVID 19.

1400 migrant labourers were counselled regularly to visit the quaterine Centre so that they could protect themselves and the corona could not spread in the community, Health check-up of Migrants labour-1150, 650 families were applied for Ration card with the collaboration of Jivika , whose didn't have Ration card. We help to Mukhiya and Ward member for distribution of Mask and Soap in the Villages.

❖ **Kishori group meeting:**

CHARDS organized Kishori group meetings in our intervention area. 2 Kishori group meeting was done in our intervention area on 24/06/2020 in Harijon tola madhubani ghat, Sariya Mushhari tola. During this meeting 40 girls were participated. Process started with registration of kishori, introduction, opening songs by girls and staff, lecture, sharing experience and participatory discussions on following issues and topics under Book of child module centre- Reproductive health care Personal health and hygiene, Self identity Good habits ,behaviour and attitude, Respect to all.

During the COVID 19 period CHARDS team aware to adolescent girls that whenever they come home from outside, they must wash their hands with sanitizer or soap. Do not touch the face again and again. If you have sneezing, head ache, fever and sore throat for more than 6 days, see a doctor as these are symptoms of corona. It's spread through droplets of cough, sneezing and cough. If the family members are coming from



other states, then inform the nearest administration about their health check-up and quarantine. Many girls realise that they have learned a lot. Many girls told that we will share information about corona virus to our parents and others.

❖ Survey regarding problems occurring during lockdown of pregnant women and adolescents:

During the lockdown period we did survey to know the problems of pregnant women and adolescent girls. 100 pregnant women and 100 teenagers were included in the survey. Some questions were asked as per the instructions of CRY which were about the problems in lockdown. Questions were related to Lack of Food, Lack of money, worry about unemployment, Concern for loss of study due to closure of school, Concern for repaying debt taken etc.

The process of project staff meeting followed with registration of project team members. Submission of weekly/monthly reports. Sharing of achievement, problems faced by internal, evaluation of done activities. We tried to evaluate our achievement, weakness, problems faced during the period. Then after we plan-out the programmes for next month. We discuss issues with the participatory way. Everyone openly shared their experiences, it thought helps us to better implementation of our activities. We covered:

❖ Help to people by flood affected of 20 villages of all three panchayat: -

At present, all the panchayats in the project area are affected by floods, so the CHARDS team helped to all those who are affected by the flood like- People get to the safe places by boat. Plastics (Tirpal) were distributed to the people by help of Mukhiya. We help to organise health camps in collaboration with ANM and MO. Also, we help in the community kitchen so that people can get food. Sprinkling of bleaching powder by meeting a ward member

More than 2 thousand households had received plastic for build their house to protect from rain. Five health camps were organised and more than one thousand women and children were received free essential medicines. More than five thousand women, children and old man received food (Garm-Garm Khana) through community kitchen. Sprinkling of Bleaching Powder to every household.



❖ Awareness on Prevention from COVID 19: -

During the pandemic of COVID 19 CHARDS team aware the community during home visit, community meeting etc. Like: -Right way to hand washing practices, how to prevent corona virus? Use of listening of Mobile Vani, how to benefited from PDS, always use of Mask and hand washing with soap. Encourage to people for health check-up. If you have sneezing, head ache, fever and sore throat for more than 6 days, see a doctor as these are symptoms of corona and call to toll free help no. 104 Social distancing Home visit and counselling on COVID 19.

MOIC, ANM and PRI members were appreciated of CHARDS work. It is being observed that more and more people are using mask and also washing hand. Many Speakers has been established to listen to mobile Vani voice so that life can be saved from corona virus.

❖ Celebration of Breast-feeding week: -

CHARDS organised it from 01-08 August 2020 at project area under the panchayat of Madhubanighat, Bardaha and Tikuliya. Resource person on 05/08/2020 were Dr. Rajkishor kumar (MO,Ad. PHC Madhubanighat), Mr. Aashish kumar (BHM,PHC Motihari) ,Mrs. Mira kumari (ANM). Consultation with ASHA, AWW and ANM on Importance of Breast feeding &our roll etc were discussed on 05/08/2020 at Campus of Ad. PHC Madhubanighat.

The process followed with registration of participant, welcome the participant, lecture, sharing and discussion with participatory way. Question and answers etc. Following topics were covered : -PWS must take rest at least 2/3 hours/ day, family member and PWS should prepare safe and institutional delivery, select comprehensive facilities at hospitals. If any problems faced pregnant Woman in last delivery then pregnant women go for delivery in hospital. The care of new born and lactating women after delivery. As per our plan we prepare some questionnaire and completed rapid survey on 100 lactating mothers in the context of breast feeding. During the rapid survey CHARDS team counselled to mothers and family members about benefits of breastfeeding etc. and distributed pamphlets.

ASHA and Anganwadi workers decided that they will visit home to bring awareness for breastfeeding. We reached to 900 family and information shared about breast feeding. 1000 Pcs pamphlets were distributed. **A Rapid survey was conducted** on 100 LW during the World breastfeeding week. The result comes out from Mothers as follow: -

- Did you feed your first milk/ colostrum to your baby soon after delivery? I got answer from mothers (Out of 100 women) Yes-78, No-22
- After birth – Did you continuously exclusively breastfeed your baby till six months? Ans-Yes-84,No-16
- How many times in a day –did you breastfeed your baby ? Ans- 80 women said 8-100 times in a day, 20 women said -5-7 times in a day.
- Do you give weaning food to your baby after six months? Ans- Yes-70, No-30
- Do you wash your hands properly before cooking, eating and feeding? Ans-100

❖ Capacity building of care givers of PW/LW:

we organised it on 23/09/2020 at Navsrijit Primary School Math tola Harajpur No. Of Participants-56 and Mrs. Pushpa Kumari (Coordinator,Heiling Peace Foundation) was the resource person. Resource person highlighted on following topics:-

- Registration in Aanganbadi centre
- Care of new born child and lactating mother.
- Supplement of nutrition food for PWs/LWs
- Knowledge share about danger sign
- Use of IFA Tablets



- Importance of T.T. and ANC/PNC
- Preparation for safe and institutional delivery
- Role and responsibilities of in-laws and male members for the care of PWs/ LWs

The whole session was quite educative for them they appreciate the resource person. Mother in-laws and other care givers members realized that PWs/LWs as well as new born child need family member support always.

❖ **Quarterly Review Meeting:** -

CHARDS organized from 26th to 28th August 2020^{at} CHARDS office Motihari through online mode. Total 10 including male and female participated in quarterly review meeting. **First day on 26/08/2020** we had review on action plan and budgeted activities. **Second day on 27/08/2020** we had presentation of achievements, non-achievement and last **day on 28/08/2020** Critical review of whole activities and financial activities were evaluated. The whole meeting was quite educative and helpful for us and will help us in future for completing the activities.

❖ **Home visiting:** -

During the period we tried our best to home visit in our intervention area. During this period project team members visited to family members for Regular GMC of children Importance of immunization, Exclusively 6 month breast feeding, Effect of child marriage, Care of SAM child and referred to NRC, to make them aware about Government health program, Counselling to women (pregnant) with danger sign , ANC,PNC and spread awareness about corona virus.

❖ **Community Meeting:** -

During this period CHARDS organised 32 community meetings in its intervention area. We continued to motivate and encourage pregnant women for safe and institutional delivery. We conduct meetings with their husband and father- mother in-laws to spread awareness and the importance of institutional delivery, ANC/PNC, Ambulance services 102, Proper sanitation, immunization, care of children and PW/LW, food habit nutritious food MCP card etc. during these all meeting some common points that came out, villagers asked for their demands and we also gave them assurance to convey their demands to the govt officials.

❖ **Celebration of National Nutrition Pakhwara:** -

National nutrition pakhwara was organised from 01 to 14 September 2020 in the various places under panchayat of Bardaha, Madhubani ghat and Tikuliya. In our monthly staff meeting we had decided that the following topics will be covered in Nutrition Pakhwara. The topics were- Child marriage, Mother health during the pregnancy period, good and healthy diet for a pregnant woman, regular health check-up, regular immunization, importance of breastfeeding, family planning, care of neonatal (Kangaroo care method), infant and children in cold season etc. we organised our first activity of nutrition pakhwara for three days on 01/09/2020 , 02/09/2020 and 03/09/2020 at panchayat bhawan Bardha , Gyandeep coaching Madhubanighat and Shiv mandir Tikuliya Harajpur ,in which Mr. Satish sharma (NRC coordinator) , Dr. Rajkishor Kumar (MO, Ad. PHC Madhubanighat) and Mrs. Meera Kumari(ANM) were the resource persons respectively. On dated 01/09/2020, 02/09/2020 and 03/09/2020 number of participants (AHSA and Sewika) were 26 , 28 and 21 respectively . In these three days of activities resource persons casted light on the GMC plotting, symptoms of malnutrition and home based management for it. These meetings were organised with the consultations ASHA worker and AWW.

We organised our second activity of nutrition Pakhwara for six days with the consultation with Adolescent girls on prevention from Malnutrition, Anaemia and nutrition diet :

The pakhwara held on 07/09/2020 was facilitated by Mr. Pramod Kumar (Art and culture minister Govt. of Bihar). we organised our third activity of nutrition Pakhwara for three days in which we organised NUKKAD SABHA with PW, LW and laid emphasis on importance of nutrition diet, locally available nutritious resources, common symptom of malnutrition and its home based management:- we organised these activities on three different dates on 11/09/2020, 12/09/2020 and 13/09/2020 at different places of our three panchayats. Total 48,30 and 57 participants participated on each date respectively.

Last day of nutrition pakhwara was concluded on 14/09/2020 in which we contacted and given counselling to mother of SAM child, completed GMC and plantation of sahjan tree was done.

After the meeting all participants said that all of this information is very important for us. Some women have started the process of making food in their home according to weekly menu, Many girls said that they will share to their parents for using locally available resources and to know its values.

❖ Two days capacity building workshop of Project staff and Adolescent girls on Breaking Gender Stereotype through using technology and Life skill

November 08,2020 was the first day of two days capacity building Program of adolescent girl is which each session had some activity, total 3 activates were done during the first session. The second session was started after lunch.

The first day of the pogram was started by the secretary of CHARDS Mr. Shashi Bhushan Prasad with the welcome and greetings of the adolescent girls and resource person. He thanked the audients for participating is the program. On the first phage of the program, the girls welcomed the guest by singing a welcome song. After this all resource persons and CHARDS team members introduced themselves. During this time CHARDS also shared its function and responsibilities among all people. In the second phase of the program, some rules and regulation



were fixed by the trainer Mrs. Akhtari Begam for these two days training program like – maintaining peace during training, not talking to each other etc. Trainer Akhtari Begum asked the adolescent girls their wishes, what do they want to learn here today? Then after the girls show their interest to discuss on the following topics like -Rights of girls, about gender discrimination about Child marriage etc. In the next phase of the program, Mrs. Reema Devi gave some important question to the girl like – Girls age of marriage, what does family discrimination means? Girl education etc, So that their ability can be evaluated. Total 10 question of this type were asked from the adolescent girls. After observing the potential of all the adolescent girls Smt. Akhtri Begam played some games with the girls. After there all activities, Mrs. Reema Devi divided adolescent girls in four groups and gave them some questions related to their problems. Trainer told them to write their problems on a chart paper after muted discussion. All girls participated on these activities quite eagerly. After this time was given for lunch.


The Second session of the program commenced with singing a song by the adolescent girls. Mrs. Akhatri Begum said to girls to proceed the discussion and ask some related questions on the task given before the lunch. She also answered the question asked by the girls. At the end of the first day of the program Mrs. Akhatri begum further explained that all of you need to be aware of your rights. She also told to the girls education is compulsory if you want to go ahead in your life then educate yourself.

Date 09.11.2020 was the second day of two days training program and all the girl eagerly participated in the training the program commenced by singing a song in which girl and also Akhatri Begum participated. Mrs. Reema Devi gave a quick session on the task discussed in the last day and asked some question from previous discussion to the girls.

After this Akhatri Begum started the second topic and said that today is our topic - when do we get energy? She said to all girls to discuss on the topic. After discussion the girls mentioned some reasons on something is not full filled then, we become energy, when some one interrupts or molest, than we become energy. Anger over discrimination between boy and girl etc. Mrs. Akhtari Begum asked to girls, how to control their anger, she explained this with some examples and also told that anger distroy our mind from which we can't achieve our goal, hence it is important to control our anger.

Resource person Mrs. Reema ji discussed on boy and girl discussion and presented some interesting examples related to it. Gender discrimination called it is a conservative ideology. After these all discussion a short break was given for tea. Mrs. Akhtari Begum welcomed to girls in the next phase of the prog. And extensively discussed the subject of patriarchal society. She explained this topic with some excellent eg.-she encourage the girls and said that women have also right to play , right to go outside, right to wear clothes according to your choice etc.

In the next lecture Mrs. Akhtari Begum discussed extensively on child marriage and explained why these not should not be child marriage in our society. Though a game she told to girls ,how dangerous it is to take stress and how it affects our health . After Reema ji told about modern technologies and said that in today's environment only male people are ahead in knowing modern technologies, In such a situation girls also need to learn modern technology. In

future, the whole world became digital, so girls need to know about modern technologies like- what sap , email,twitter,facebook and use of internet etc.

The capacity building workshop end with game in which the participants were divided into two teams. All the participants pledged to maintain friendship by tying friendship ribbon to each others, in which the CHARDS team also participated.

❖ Relief work by CHARDS for the community under adverse condition of COVID-19 and flood

At the time of lockdown CHARDS organization provided ration among the marginalised community in its intervention area. The following people were included in that marginalized community: malnourished children, widows, pregnant women, those people who have lack of daily food. CHARDS provided ration to the 472 downtrodden poor families. In which per family rice-14kg, Arhar Daal/pulse- 1kg, Masur Daal/Pulse- 1kg, mustard oil – ½ ltr, Soyabin- ½ kg, Sugar- 1kg was distributed.

During this time 200 Mask and 200 handwash were distributed among ASHA workers, AWW workers, ANM of Madhubanighat , Bardaha and Tikuliya panchayat. During this period sanitary pad and soap (per adolescent girls-3 pockets sanitary pads and lifebuoy soap- 5 pcs, savlon soap- 5pcs, Detol soap-5 pcs)were also distributed among adolescent girls..

❖ Celebration of Human Rights day:- Human Rights day was organised on 10/Dec/2020 in the meeting hall of Hiralala Shah Middle School in Motihari. This event was presided by Lalan Prasad (President of Motijheel footpath Dukandaar Association), He said that there is a need of strong and concrete initiatives to protect Human Rights. He further said that government makes the rule and regulations but the needy do not get its benefit on the right time, a initiative must be taken to provide legal Rights to all citizens of the society. Mr Azhar Ansari a social worker also said that conscious people of the society should also understand their responsibilities. In the seminar education, discrimination, equality before law, appropriate tribunal, arbitrary arrest, right of freedom, right to meeting or assembly, election/polling, social security, right to a reasonable standard of living , child rights, education for all etc. topics were extensively discussed.

❖ CHILDLINE (Sub Centre Chakiya)

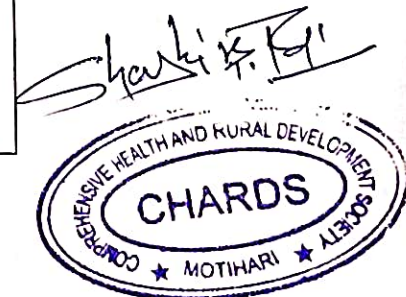
3. Awareness programmes conducted:

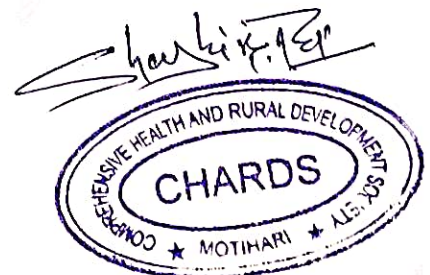
